
## Email configuration in SAM PuttLab

To send emails directly from the SAM PuttLab software a valid email account has to be configured in the email settings.

To do this go to the Program Settings and then to section "Email (Report)":



In the settings page click the option: "Directly send emails from PuttLab (SMTP)"

C Use MAPI to send Emails	
With MAPI protocol emails will be sent through your default Email Client account (Outlook, Thunderbird)	Test MAPI Email

To send emails by SMTP protocol you need to fully configure your email account in PuttLab (Mail server and password etc.)	Configure SMTP

Then press the button "Configure SMTP"

In the following dialog all relevant email account settings have to be entered.

The account settings come from your email provider, at least you need to know your user name (in most cases this is just the full email address) and your password.
